We are a group actively involved in many aspects of the radio controlled model aircraft hobby including electric and glow power systems, slope flying, scale and helicopters. The FARCAA is a chartered club of the Academy of Model Aeronautics holding charter # 4634.

We fly at our club field and at Woahlnk Lake. The club web site www.farcaa.org has a schedule of club flying activities. Members of the club regularly meet and fly on Sunday and Monday mornings all year and add Wednesdays and Friday mornings during the summer flying season.

Club Flying Activities

The club flying site is located on the northeast corner of the Florence Municipal Airport. Access to the site is limited to club members and approved guests. Flying at the site is authorized only after a safety check.

Training

A number of club members are willing to instruct. It is easiest to contact them by calling a club officer who's telephone numbers are listed in this brochure.

Membership

FARCAA flying membership is open to anyone who is a current member of the Academy of Model Aeronautics. There are two regular meetings each year, one at the beginning of the flying season, and one at the end. The first meeting is normally held at the Florence Airport on the first Sunday of May and the second meeting is normally held at the airport or other designated location on the first Sunday of October. Dues for regular flying membership in the club are currently \$40 per year and \$20 for Park Flyer members. There is a one time \$50 field fee as well. The club's fiscal year begins on November 1 and ends on October 31. The club's constitution and by-laws may be downloaded from the club web site www.farcaa.org. An application for membership may also be downloaded from the club web site.

The club normally publishes a newsletter available in print or on its web site at the beginning, middle and end of each flying season.
